



**B.B. KING HOMECOMING:
Blues, Bikes & BBQ
July 2 & 3, 2010**

You are cordially invited to participate in the BB King Homecoming: *Blues, Bikes & BBQ* to be held on Saturday, July 3rd beginning at 9:00 a.m. in Indianola.

1. Space size is 10' x 10.'
2. Space fee: \$50.00 for merchandise vendors; \$250.00 for food vendors, and \$25.00 for previous participants in the Indianola Open Air Market (IOAM). There is an additional charge of \$30.00 for electricity.
3. Space is available around the BB King Museum area. Requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis. All booth assignments are final. Booth assignments will be made as applications are received. Deadline for receipt of applications is JUNE 19, 2010.
4. Food vendors will be selected on variety of food, number of applications received and date the application is received. Also, please follow the Health Department's rules and regulations. "TEAM INDIANOLA" CONCESSION WILL BE SELLING CATFISH BASKETS, GRILLED CORN, SOFT DRINKS AND BEER – NO OTHER VENDOR WILL BE ALLOWED TO SELL THESE ITEMS.
5. Vendors may start setting up on Saturday, July 3rd at 6:00 a.m. Limited security will be provided.
6. All vehicles must be out of the festival area by 8:00 a.m.
7. All vendors MUST have their own tent.
8. Exhibitors must assume full responsibility for display, sales, care of his/her craft and booth.
9. The BB King Homecoming – Blues, Bikes & BBQ will not be responsible for any loss or damage to booth or injury to any participating persons. There will be police officers present throughout the day.
10. There will be no knives, guns, or weapons of any type allowed, including toys that look like weapons or maybe used as weapons. This includes "silly string," "fart bags," novelty cigarettes, and air soft rifles. If you have questions regarding your merchandise, contact us at the numbers listed below.
11. The festival reserves the right to remove work not deemed suitable for sale at our family oriented festival.
12. All exhibitors are responsible for collecting sales tax at the rate of 7%. Tax envelopes will be provided. Taxes must be turned into the IOAM information tent before you leave for the day.
13. All Exhibitors must stay until the event closes.
14. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning trash from their booth areas.
